

Richard Schmalz was my dad. As a husband, he was a faithful companion. As a father, he was a loving and supportive parent. As a member of Joy Lutheran, he was committed to help in whatever way he could to carry out our mission to Experience Faith, Know Love and Share Joy.


He would be so happy to see how the Holy Spirit is at work at Joy Lutheran and is, I know, looking JOYfully down from heaven right now. I recall so many conversations he and I had in the last few years about why we do what we do as Christians. His answer was always some variation of "so the next generation can come to know the love of Jesus." He LOVED to see kids in church, even if they were loud and disruptive. His point was that having an active Youth Ministry is exactly what we promise to do during baptism...that we support parents in bringing ids to worship, teaching them the Lord's Prayer and the commandments, and placing the scriptures in their hands.

As many of you know, my dad died in January at the age of nearly 93. His wishes were very clear regarding his estate: While it was not large, he wanted 20% of it to go to Joy with the specific instruction that it must be spent as soon as possible to further the mission of the church. Consistent with the parable of the talents told in Matthew 25, he did not was his gift to just sit in a savings account. Therefore, my brothers and I want to ensure his wishes are carried out, and after discussion with Pastor Angie, we believe the best use of his gracious generosity was to cover the cost of a Youth Director for one year.

Pastor Angie indicated that it would be tough to find someone willing and capable to fill this role. BUT, the Holy Spirit was at work, and we have been bleed to find Heather Zimmer. Personally, I think my dad was working on this too up in heaven!

JOY LUTHERAN WELCA


Did you know...that Joy Lutheran Church is a member of the Apple River Conference of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin? Wisconsin has 5 synods, so we are pretty heavily populated with ELCA Lutherans in the state! There are approximately 28 churches in the Apple River Conference. The Apple River Conference is an active conference with many events and the Women of the ELCA are an integral part of it.

On Saturday, September 7th, the Apple River Conference of the Women of the ELCA will host our Fall event at Faith Lutheran Church in Grantsburg. Our speaker will be Pati Kachel, who is a storyteller by profession. She will be portraying Corrie Tem Boom, who, along with her family, helped many Jews escape from the Nazi's. Corrie has written books on her life, such as "The Hiding Place". This will be a program you will not want to miss! The day starts with coffee and registration between 8 and 9 a.m and ends with lunch at noon. All women are invited and bring your friends. Please register with Nancy Priebe at 715-645-0947 as soon as possible. The fee is \$15 for the day. Come and experience a spirit led morning and learn some history.

Another event in September is the SWO Convention in Eau Claire on the 27th and 28th. SWO stands for Synodical Women's Organization, of which Apple River Conference is a part. This event is also open to all women. On Friday evening, the 27th, is the business meeting and each congregation may send one delegate for the purpose of voting. However, anyone may attend this session. On Saturday, the 28th, will be a keynote speaker and several awareness sessions. The theme for the event is "Day of Awareness" focusing on "Caring for God's Creation" Renew - Reuse - Repurpose. Please check the women's section in the Narthex for more information. Registration for this event ends on September 18th and the fee is \$30.


